**Intoxicating liquor license; required -- Eligibility; fees**

- (1) For the manufacturing, distilling or blending of intoxicating liquor in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight \$ 375.00
- (2) For the manufacturing, distilling or blending of intoxicating liquor not in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight \$ 375.00
- (3) For the sale by wholesale of intoxicating liquor which is in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight \$ 300.00
- (4) For the sale by wholesale of intoxicating liquor not in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight by wholesale \$ 75.00
- (5) For the sale of intoxicating liquors in excess of five percent alcohol by weight by retail \$ 150.00
- (6) For the sale of intoxicating liquor not in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight by retail \$ 52.50
- (7) For the sale of malt liquor containing alcohol in excess of 3.2 percent by weight and not in excess of five percent by weight, by grocers and other merchants and dealers for sale in the original package direct to consumers but not for resale \$ 22.50
- (8) For the sale of intoxicating liquor by-the-drink at retail for consumption on the premises \$ 450.00
- (9) For the sale of intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises in a "restaurant bar" as defined by RSMo. § 311.097, 1969, as amended, on Sundays between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight \$ 300.00
- (10) For the sale of five percent beer by the drink to 14 percent wine \$ 52.50
- (11) For the sale of five percent beer by the drink seven days a week \$ 75.00
- (12) For the consumption of intoxicating liquor \$ 90.00
- (13) For the sale of intoxicating liquor in the original package at retail between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on Sundays \$ 300.00
- (14) Any business possessing the qualifications and meeting the requirements of this chapter, who is licensed to sell intoxicating liquor in the original package at retail, may make application to the city clerk for a special permit to conduct wine, malt beverage and distilled spirit tastings on the licensed premises. \$ 37.50

Violations Bureau

Pursuant to 479.050. RSMO, Supreme Court Rule 37.495, the undersigned Municipal Judge of Mexico Municipal Division hereby orders that the following designated offenses shall be prepayable to the City of Mexico Violations Bureau. In such cases, if the fine and costs total is paid **BEFORE THE COURT DATE** on the citation, no court appearance is necessary. The stated fines reflect the prepay amount if paid out of court at the Violations Bureau. After a summons has been issued, or during court the Judge may assess a fine different than the prepayable amount.

**ALL OTHER VIOLATIONS NOT SPECIFICALLY LISTED REQUIRE A COURT APPEARANCE AND ARE NOT PREPAYABLE. THIS INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO SPEEDING IN A SCHOOL/CONSTRUCTION ZONE AND ANY INCIDENT INVOLVING AN ACCIDENT.**

Streets, Sidewalks and Other Public Places

Article III. Construction and Maintenance of Sidewalks and Driveways

Division 1. Generally

**Section 34 - 99 Permit required to construct sidewalk or driveway; permit fees**

In addition to any fine that may be imposed by the municipal judge, there shall be assessed in all cases the following:

No person shall undertake the construction or reconstruction of any sidewalk or driveway without having first obtained a permit to do so from the city engineer. The fee for a permit to construct or reconstruct a sidewalk or a driveway, where no grades are to be set and no engineering work is necessary, shall be the sum of two dollars (\$2.00). Where it is necessary for grades to be set or for any engineering work to be done, the fee for such permit shall be ten dollars (\$10.00). All fees shall be payable to the city. When a sidewalk or driveway is to be constructed in connection with the erection of a new or remodeled structure for which a building permit has been issued, no permit fee shall be charged unless engineering work by the city is required, in which case the regular ten-dollar permit fee shall apply.

Division 2. Permit

**Section 34 -199. Same--Contents of application; fee**

Application for an excavation permit shall be made in writing to the city engineer. The application shall contain such information as the building official may require regarding the purpose, location and size of the proposed excavation and the approximate time when the work thereon will be commenced and completed. A separate permit shall be required for each excavation and a fee, of \$20.00 shall be paid by the applicant to the city for each such permit issued.

## Zoning

### Division 3. Records Fees

Section 42-85. Appeals to the board --To whom available; time limit and procedure.  
Appeals to the zoning board of adjustment on any matter over which the board is by this division specifically granted jurisdiction may be taken by any person aggrieved, or by any officer, department, board or bureau of the city affected by any decision of the administrative officer. Such appeal shall be taken within a reasonable time, as provided by the rules of the board, by filing with the officer from whom the appeal is taken and with the zoning board of adjustment a notice of appeal specifying the grounds thereof and a **processing fee of \$150.00** has been paid. The officer from whom the appeal is taken shall forthwith transmit to the board all the papers constituting the record upon which the action appealed from is taken.
